**Title:** Storage Stability Data

**Details:** In order to convert to a full registration from conditional registration, the applicant must provide a new storage stability study, in which at least 3 separate packages are each sampled at least 3 times at the 0, 3, 6, 9, and 12 month time periods. Thus, there should be at least 15 packages of product and at least 3 packages should be opened and used at each of the 0, 3, 6, 9, and 12 month marks. This new study must be provided to PMRA upon completion; in the meantime, an expected completion data must be provided. In addition, until this new study is submitted and reviewed the guarantee statement on the label must either include the term “when packed” or a best before date.
