DIRECTIONS FOR USE: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Use only in well ventilated areas, preferably outdoors. ON PETS: Hold container in upright position and spray the animal from a distance of 20-30 cm. Spray the entire body of the pet, beginning at the tail and working towards the head. Do NOT spray animal's face, eyes or genitals. Pay special attention to neck, hindquarters, areas under legs, around the tail and between toes. Do NOT use on dogs or cats under 12 weeks or age. Consult a veterinarian before using on sick, aged, pregnant or nursing animals or animals receiving drug or other pesticide treatment. Do NOT use this spray more often than once every 2 days. Treatment must be repeated only if the pest problem persists or reoccurs. ON PREMISES: To control fleas and brown dog ticks on premises: thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, mouldings, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor covering. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Concurrent treatment of animals is recommended. Treatment must only be repeated if pest problem reoccurs.

PRECAUTIONS: HUMANS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. May irritate eyes, nose and throat. Avoid contact with pet until dry. After handling or applying, wash hands (or any other skin that came into contact with the product) with soap and water. Avoid product contact with food, food utensils or places where food is prepared or stored. PETS: Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. May irritate eyes, nose and throat. Avoid direct spray of dog's or cat's mouth, face, eyes and genitals. Toxic to fish and other aquatic life. Cover fish aquaria in vicinity of treatment area. Toxic to birds. Discontinue use if dermal or nasal irritations develop

FIRST AID: IF SWALLOWED, Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING, Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes.

Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and P.C.P. Registration Number with you when seeking medical or veterinary attention.

PETS: Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe the pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in garbage collection.
