DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Kills Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps, Gnats, flying Moths, Cockroaches, spiders, crickets, ants, carpet beetles, centipedes and silverfish

For use as a domestic space and contact spray.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

Hold can upright while spraying.

TO KILL HOUSE PESTS:

” FLYING INSECTS” - Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps, Gnats and flying Moths.

Close doors and windows. Direct mist upwards in sweeping motion to all parts of the room especially windows and other light sources. Apply 6 to 10 seconds burst per 30 cubic metres of space. Whenever possible, keep doors and windows closed for 15 minutes after each treatment. Also direct mist into areas where insects are present. Keep spray at least 1 metre from interior wall, fabrics and furniture. Vacate treated area and ventilate room well after use.

“ CRAWLING INSECTS ” - Cockroaches, spiders, crickets, ants,

carpet beetles, centipedes and silverfish. Spray hiding places such as base boards, moist areas, openings around sinks, drains and pipes, behind cabinets and storage areas. Spray ant trails, around door sills, window frames, or in ant nests. Insects must be hit to be killed.

“BED BUGS” - Spray mattress, particularly around seams and tufts. Take beds apart, spray all joints. Repeat as required.

“FLEAS” - Spray sleeping quarters of pets. Change bedding if possible. **DO NOT USE ON PETS.**

TO KILL GARDEN PESTS: ON FLOWERS AND ORNAMENTALS

“SUCKING INSECTS” - Exposed thrips, leaf-hoppers, spotted mites, lace bugs, aphids.

“CHEWING INSECTS” - Caterpillars, climbing cutworms, Japanese Beetles.

For insects on Asters, Azaleas, Begonias, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Delphiniums, Gladioli, Irises, Marigolds, Petunias, Roses, and Snapdragons, Evergreens, small Deciduous trees, Shrubs and Vines.

Carefully spray with slow sweeping motion keeping 30 cm. to 45 cm. away from the plants to avoid wetting the foliage. A light spray kills pests effectively. Spray only when air is still and temperature is under 32 degrees C. Do not spray in direct sunlight. Early morning or evening is preferred. Use with caution on young plants and new growth. Insects must be contacted by spray to be killed.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat. **DO** not puncture or incinerate container, or store at temperatures over 50 degrees C. **DO NOT USE ON ANIMALS OR HUMANS.** Cover fish bowls and remove pets for one hour when spraying rooms. In homes or dwellings, remove or cover all exposed foods and cooking utensils before spraying. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, clothing. Avoid inhalation of spray. Wash after using. Keep from freezing. Do not use on Maiden Hair Ferns. Do not use on vegetable or fruit crops.

FIRST AID: - Avoid inhalation or exposure of spray to eyes. **If in eyes,** hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If inhaled,** move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. **If swallowed,** call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press button to release all pressure.

DO NOT THROW INTO FIRE. Wrap and dispose in household garbage.
