WARNING

Exposure to Captan may produce long-term health effects. To minimize exposure, follow directions outlined on this label.

CONTROLS:

Aphids, mites, rose chafers, leafhoppers, sawfly, spruce budworm, tent caterpillars, leaf miners and other chewing insects on roses, evergreens, conifers and other ornamental flowers and shrubs. Controls black spot, powdery mildew on roses, flowers and ornamentals and blight on junipers.

DIRECTIONS:

For outdoor use only. Avoid application of this product when winds are gusty. DO NOT apply to any body of water. DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Squeeze container to apply a light even coating to upper and lower leaf surfaces.

NOTE:

1. Do not use on Boston ivy or Virginia creeper.
2. HIGHLY TOXIC TO BEES. Do not apply directly to flowers or when bees are active.

FIRST AID:

In case of poisoning, call a physician or Poison Control Centre immediately. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention. IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 -20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. IF IN EYES, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing the eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. IF SWALLOWED, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

This product contains Malathion and Carbaryl which are cholinesterase inhibitors (anti-cholinesterase compounds). Symptoms of human poisoning may include headache, weakness, sweating, blurred vision, nausea and diarrhea. Obtain medical attention or call a poison control centre at once. Atropine is antidotal.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

TOXIC to birds and aquatic organisms.

STORAGE:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Keep in original container during storage. Isomalathion, a toxic metabolite of malathion forms when malathion product is stored at elevated temperatures or for extended periods of time. Malathion product must be stored in a cool (<20-23°C), dry, well ventilated place away from seed fertilizer or other pesticides and for no longer than one year.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Poisonous if swallowed. Never handle material with bare hands. Use rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash hands, face and arms thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before drinking, eating or using tobacco. Do not breathe dust. When handling or applying, wear goggles and clothing that completely covers arms and legs to minimize exposure. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before use. If an accident occurs, remove contaminated clothing immediately, and wash contaminated skin thoroughly with soap and water. Wash clothing and gloves before re-use. Always work out of the wind when handling, or applying treatments. Keep unprotected persons out of operating area or vicinity where there may be drift. Avoid contamination of food and feed.

DISPOSAL:

Do not reuse empty container. Discard empty containers with household garbage.
