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BUG-X Ready-To-Use Residual Household Insect Spray provides rapid kill of such crawling insects as listed below.

Ants	Flies
Brown dog ticks	Hornets
Clover mites	Millipedes
Crickets	Sowbugs
Earwigs	Spiders
Fleas	Wasps

In addition to rapid kill, BUG-X Ready-To-Use Residual Household Spray stays on treated surfaces and kills insects many weeks after the spray deposit has dried.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: For outdoor use only. Do not use indoors. Outdoor application is limited to crack and crevice, structural, and stinging insect nest treatments and must not be applied to vegetation, plants, grass and/or any area accessible to children. BUG-X Ready-To-Use Residual Household Insect Spray is ready to use undiluted as it comes from the can, and may be applied with hand sprayers. Apply as a coarse spray to infested surfaces until wet, moving the spray stream rapidly enough to prevent excessive wetting of surfaces and waste of material. Direct spray away from people, plants and pets.

Outdoor use: ANTS, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, FLEAS, FLIES, HORNETS, MILLIPEDES, SOWBUGS, BROWN DOG TICKS AND WASPS: Spray infested areas thoroughly including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, or other places where insects may enter. For ants spray places where ants enter premises. For control of wasps and hornets, spray nests at night. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Contact with skin, eyes, or clothing should also be avoided. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling. Do not spray near open flame or spark. Do not smoke while using. Do not store near excessive heat. Do not contaminate feed or food. Avoid excessive wetting of plastics, rubber and asphalt materials such as tiles and floor coverings. Do not use as a space spray. Do not treat animals, humans, plants, or food utensils. Provide adequate ventilation of area being treated.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give **any** liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If on skin or clothing,** take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If in eyes,** hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: This product contains a pesticide that is a cholinesterase inhibitor (anti-cholinesterase compound). Symptoms of human poisoning may include a sense of "tightness" in the chest, headache, weakness, sweating, blurred vision, contracted pupils, stomach pains, nausea, and diarrhea. Obtain medical treatment or call a poison centre at once. Atropine is antidotal, administered in large therapeutic doses repeated as necessary to the point of tolerance. Do not give morphine. Watch for pulmonary edema, which may develop in serious cases of poisoning even after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically. This product contains petroleum distillate..

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and dispose of empty container in household garbage.
