DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To Treat Cooling Water Systems

An initial slug addition of 35.0-87.5 millilitres of Series 3001 per 1000 litres should be employed. For maintenance add 10.0-87.5 ml. The required frequency of addition will depend upon the relative amount of bleed-off and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump of water cooling towers.

DISPOSAL:

- 1. Triple or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.
- 2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to disposal.
- 3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
- 4. Dispose of the container in accordance with Provincial requirements.
