DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Hyamine 1622 Crystals is a concentrate for formulating purposes only. To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Corrosive, causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Fatal or poisonous if swallowed. Harmful or fatal if absorbed through the skin or inhaled. Do not inhale dust or vapours. Wear chemical-resistant gloves, long pants, a long-sleeved shirt and shoes when handling this concentrate. Avoid contamination of food. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls.

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters.

NOTE: This product should not be used or compounded with any reducing or oxidizing agents (such as calcium hypochlorite, solid perchlorate or nitric acid) since such admixtures may be explosive.

Do not use in conjunction with soap or any anionic wetting agent.

FIRST AID:

En cas d'inhalation, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

In case of contact with skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

DISPOSAL:
