IMPORTANT PRODUCT USE INFORMATION:

To Use Trigger Sprayer:

1. Remove sprayer from bag.
2. Unscrew cap from container and set aside. Do not throw out.
3. Be sure that tube is properly positioned in hole in cap, then insert tube into bottle and screw on cap.
4. Open nozzle about one turn.
5. Point sprayer at desired area, and pump trigger sprayer until spray begins.
6. Adjust nozzle as desired.....fine stream for spot treatment, wide mist for broad application.
7. When temporarily not in use, keep nozzle above liquid level of container to prevent leakage from nozzle.
8. To store remove nozzle and re-cap container with original cap.
9. Rinse nozzle with clear water before storing, taking care to avoid contact with dip tube. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after each use. **STORE OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.**
10. Store nozzle in re-sealable plastic bag provided.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Spray plants to thorough wetting. For use on vegetables, fruits, ornamentals and flowering plants.

Powdery mildew: on roses, chrysanthemums, grapes, strawberries, currants, gooseberries, beans and dahlias. Concord grapes and other sulphur-shy varieties of plants may be sensitive to this product. Spray at first sign of disease and repeat at 10-14 day intervals.

Black spot: on roses. Spray every 7-10 days to ensure thorough coverage on new foliage and stems.

Rust: on currants, gooseberries, beans and ornamentals, spray at first sign of disease and repeat at 10-14 day intervals as necessary.

Harvest Interval: Apply up to 1 day before harvest for all crops except wine grapes, which require a 21-day interval.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not apply within 30 days of an oil treatment or at high temperatures. Do not apply to Boston fern. Avoid contamination of food and feed. Do not heat or store at high temperatures.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and dispose of empty container in household garbage.

FIRST AID: IF SWALLOWED, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. IF IN EYES, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.
