DIRECTIONS:

Thoroughly brush articles to be stored. Place garments, woolens, furs, etc. in an airtight trunk or chest. Use 16 g of Naphthalene Moth Balls for 10,000 cc (45 g per cu. ft.) of the trunk or chest. Seal all joints and holes of the container with adhesive tape to prevent loss of vapour. To remove odour, brush garments or hang in sunlight. Not effective in closets in everyday use.

PRECAUTIONS:

May be harmful if swallowed. **KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** The physical form of moth balls is an attractive hazard to children. If stored in contact with infant's clothing, air garments thoroughly before use.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL:

Do not reuse empty container. Discard in household garbage.
