FIRST AID

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Preventol DBDCB 25 is typically effective when applied at the concentrations shown. All concentrations are based on total formulation weight.

Method of Addition

Aqueous Paints (including heating & air conditioning systems): Incorporate into the makeup water during the grind.

Latex Emulsions: Add using moderate agitation immediately following the cool-down of the emulsion and prior to entering the storage tank facilities.

Adhesives: Incorporate with agitation into the makeup water blend. However, where the adhesive is heated, Preventol DBDCB 25 should be added during the cool-down cycle.

Dispersed Pigments: Add using moderate agitation immediately following the cool down of the dispersed pigment and prior to entering the storage tank facilities.

Joint Cements: Incorporate with agitation into the makeup water blend.

Metalworking Fluids: Add to the final diluted cutting fluid, either prior to its addition to the system, or after the system has been filled. Preventol DBDCB 25 should be thoroughly mixed into the system to assure efficacy. If Preventol DBDCB 25 is added to the concentrate, testing should be done to assure compatibility.

Liquid Detergents, Waxes, Polishes, Inks, Laundry Starches, Fabric Softeners, Textile Sizes: Incorporate into the makeup water blend with moderate agitation.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

KEEP CONTAINER CLOSED WHEN NOT IN USE. DO NOT REUSE EMPTY CONTAINER.

- 1. Rinse the empty container thoroughly. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.
- 2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
