DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Do NOT administer by mouth. Wet dog thoroughly. Avoiding eyes and mouth, apply shampoo, working lather down to skin, starting at the head and working back until entire body is covered with lather. Do NOT treat eyes, mouth or genitals. Allow foam to remain for 5-10 minutes. Rinse well and dry. Do NOT use on dogs under 12 weeks of age. Consult a veterinarian before using on sick, aged, pregnant or nursing animals or animals receiving drug or other pesticide treatment. Do NOT use this shampoo more often than once every 2 weeks. Treatment must only be repeated if pest problem reoccurs. Do NOT use solely as a shampoo when there is no pest problem.

For effective flea and tick control, treatment of the pet must be combined with the cleanup and sanitation of any area used by the pet. Vacuum floors, carpets, furniture, etc. (discard vacuum bag after use) and wash the pet's bedding, living quarters and surrounding areas. A veterinarian should be consulted if pest infestation continues to be a problem on the pet. If pest problem persists, an insecticidal premise treatment may be required.

PRECAUTIONS: HUMANS: Use rubber gloves. Avoid contact with pets until dry. After handling or applying, wash hands (or any other skin that came in contact with the product) with soap and water. Avoid product contact with food, food utensils or places where food is prepared or stored. PETS: Keep away from animal's eyes, mouth and genitals. Discontinue use if adverse effects are observed or if animal develops dermal irritation.

FIRST AID: HUMANS

In case of contact with eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. In case of contact with skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. In case of contact via inhalation, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. In case of ingestion, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

PETS: Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe the pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

Take container, label or product name and P.C.P. Registration Number with you when seeking medical or veterinary attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Contains petroleum distillate. Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap and dispose of empty container with household garbage.
