DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Kills aphids and whitefly indoors and outdoors on houseplants, vegetables, shrubs and ornamentals. **Aphids:** Aphids fly outdoors from early spring throughout the summer and occur year round on plants indoors. Spray when sighted on buds, new shoots, stems and undersides of leaves. Repeat applications weekly for 2-3 weeks and thereafter as required.

Whiteflies: These tiny moth-like insects can be found throughout the year on the undersides of leaves on indoor plants and throughout the growing season on outdoor plantings. Repeat applications at two week intervals as required to control the scale-like larvae hatching from eggs.

May be used up to day of harvest.
