DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Dosages and method of application of CSW 850 will depend on the type of equipment to be treated and the type and quantity of microbiological life involved prior to the use of CSW 850, removal of slime, algae, deposits and flushing of the cooling system should be performed.

Apply the product using a closed delivery system such as a dry coupling and/or metering pump.

Initial dosage of 0.7 L to 2.0 L per 10 000 L of water in the system (approximately equivalent to 10 to 30 ppm active ingredient). Continuing dosages should be applied at 0.33 L to 1.33 L per 10 000 L of water in the system (approximately equivalent to 5 to 20 ppm active ingredient) at intervals of every 2 to 5 days or as needed.

Slug fed additions should be made to cooling tower basin or sump or an alternate point which provides good mixing.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Wear goggles or face shield, chemical-resistant gloves, long pants, a long-sleeved shirt, and shoes and socks when handling. Wash promptly and thoroughly with an abrasive soap and cool water and finally with glycerin. Keep the drum closed when not in use. Do not reuse container, destroy when empty. Do not use in potable water system.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Treat symptomatically.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

Toxic to birds. Toxic to aquatic organisms. DO NOT discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems, lakes streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters.

DISPOSAL:

1. Triple- or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.
 2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
 3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
 4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
 5. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency.
