PRECAUTIONS PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED DANGER - EYE IRRITANT MAY CAUSE SKIN IRRITATION AVOID INHALATION

Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear impervious gloves and chemical worker's goggles when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Discard contaminated leather articles.

FIRST AID

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

No specific antidote. Employ supportive care. Treatment should be based on judgment of the physician in response to reactions of the patient. High concentrations of MCPA may cause severe irritation to the eyes. Symptoms of overexposure to MCPA could include slurred speech, twitching, jerking and spasms, drooling, low blood pressure and unconsciousness. Treat symptomatically.

STORAGE

Keep in original container during storage. Store in a cool, dry well ventilated place away from seed, feed, fertilizer or other pesticides. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do NOT store in freezing temperatures. If allowed to freeze, remix before using.

DISPOSAL

Canadian formulators of this technical should dispose of unwanted active and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations. For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency. SPILLAGE CLEAN-UP

Keep bystanders away. Do not smoke, drink or eat during cleanup operations. Wear protective equipment (coveralls, rubber boots, and protective gloves). Absorb the liquid onto soil, sawdust or other suitable absorbent material and shovel into a drum, add broken packages to the drum and seal for removal to an approved disposal site.
