INSECT CONTROLLER

A physical control to which insects CANNOT build up a resistance.

Kills earwigs, cockroaches, beetles, spiders, ants, fleas, silverfish, bedbugs, crickets, grain insects and other crawling insects.

This product is odour-free, does not discolour and is not harmful to animals, fish, fowl, or food, if label directions are followed. Remains effective in the control of insects for as long as INSECT STOP™ is present.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Lightly coat the areas where insects are found and may hide such as cracks and crevices under and around equipment, pipes and drainage systems window frames, floorboards and entrance ways. Apply INSECT STOP™ at a rate of 500 g/100 m² with a manual dust applicator. Hit insects directly where possible, the insects cannot brush it off. The powder cuts through the insect's waxy outer layer which leads to a loss of bodily fluids and death. Repeat treatment if pests reappear or after cleaning.

SPRAY APPLICATION: Apply to a point of wetness using 75 g of INSECT STOP™ in 1 litre of water per 10 m². Note: Whenever sprayed, the powder controls the insects until it is washed away.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. In food processing plants, apply only when plant is not in operation. Cover or remove all food processing equipment, packaging material and utensils before application. Wash all surfaces that may contact food and rinse with potable water before re-use. Avoid breathing dust. Do not use as a general space spray. Avoid contact with eyes. Wash hands after application. Wear a suitable dust mask approved by NIOSH/MSHA when handling. When using a dust blower, wear a NIOSH-approved supplied-air respirator (SAR) operated in a pressure-demand or other positive-pressure mode during mixing, loading and application. Unprotected personnel should not enter the area during application or subsequent clean up.

FIRST AID: In case of contact with skin, flush with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. In case of contact with eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If inhaled, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL: Thoroughly empty the contents of the container into the dust applicator. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use. Dispose of container in accordance with provincial requirements.
