Non-staining, non-flammable. Kills flying insects such as flies, mosquitoes, flying moths, gnats, wasps, and crawling insects such as cockroaches, ants, silverfish, spiders, centipedes, carpet beetles, bedbugs, crickets, fleas.

Use in homes, cottages, cabins, trailers, tents, attics, basements, garbage cans, animal and farm buildings (barns, stables, storage rooms).

DIRECTIONS: SHAKE BEFORE USING. To spray, point valve opening away from face and press button.

FLYING INSECTS: Flies, mosquitoes, flying moths, gnats, wasps. Close all doors and windows. Spray up into the air with sweeping motion keeping about 1 m from interior walls, fabrics and furniture. Keep room closed for 15 minutes. Ventilate sealed areas after treatment. About 12 seconds of spraying clears an average size room (28 cubic metres).

CRAWLING INSECTS: Cockroaches, silverfish, fleas. Spray hiding places such as baseboards, cracks, openings around plumbing, behind cabinets, etc. Crawling insects must be hit with spray to be killed.

ANTS: Spray trails, hills, around windows and sills and openings around pipes and baseboards where ants crawl, hitting as many as possible.

FLEAS: Spray floors, floor coverings and sleeping quarters of pets. Repeat spraying as often as necessary.

SPIDERS AND CENTIPEDES: Spray webs and crawling places, hitting all visible pests.

CARPET BEETLES: Hit these bugs directly on section of floor, baseboards and underside of carpets. Repeat at frequent intervals.

BED BUGS: Take beds apart. Spray frames, joints, mattresses, particularly tufts and seams, floor boards, mouldings, baseboards. Repeat at frequent intervals.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Cover fish bowls and remove animals for one hour when spraying rooms. Avoid inhalation. Cover food and food utensils. Do not spray directly on skin or animals. **KEEP FROM FREEZING. CONTENTS UNDER PRESSURE.** Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves, or other sources of heat. Do not puncture or incinerate container or store at temperatures over 50 deg C.

FIRST AID: If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated

clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically. This product contains petroleum distillates. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press valve to release all remaining pressure. Wrap and dispose of empty container with household garbage.
