**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

Sergeant's Shoo Outdoor Granular Repellent is formulated to prevent dogs and cats, both pets and stray animals, from soiling lawns, flower beds, ornamental shrubs and evergreens.

The most effective control for a pet is the sharply spoken word backed up with disciplinary action. This product should be used in conjunction with training until undesirable habit is broken.

First, remove any pet droppings and sprinkle granules lightly over area to prevent attracting stray animals.

Apply granules by hand or with a fertilizer spreader. This package will cover 35 m<sup>2</sup>. Apply at a rate of 20 g per m<sup>2</sup> (20 g is equivalent to 33 mL or 2.2 tablespoons). Treat borders of flower beds, around trees, shrubs, evergreens, or patches of lawn. Repeat applications until the undesirable animal habits are broken. Repeat application after rains.

Garbage cans and other areas can be protected from disturbance by dogs and cats by a liberal sprinkling of granules on the ground or floor about them. Repeat as necessary.

Do not apply directly to foliage or shrubs or to ornamental, soft-bodied plants. Apply only in areas adjacent to buildings. Do not apply in wildlife habitat areas (e.g. parklands, forested lands).

**PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Avoid contamination of food. Do not apply to food/feed crops or use on animals. Wear rubber gloves when applying this product by hand. Avoid contact with skin. Wash hands with soap and water after use. Do not apply this product in a way that it will contact any person or pet, either directly or through drift. Do not apply directly to aquatic habitats (such as lakes, rivers, sloughs, ponds, coulees, prairie potholes, creeks, marshes, streams, reservoirs or wetlands) or stuarine/marine habitats. DO NOT contaminate water by cleaning equipment or disposing of wastes.

**FIRST AID: In case of ingestion,** call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If on skin or clothing,** take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If in eyes,** hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and P.C.P. Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Treat symptomatically.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty container and discard in household garbage.
