DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To be used only in the manufacture of products that are registered under the authority of the Pest Control Products Act.

PRECAUTIONS

FIRST AID

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.
