DIRECTIONS:

Later's Calcide Liquid Vegetation Killer is a non-selective herbicide that can be easily used to control weeds, grasses or other undesirable vegetation in driveways, brick walks, paths, patios, parking areas, along fence lines and curbs. Mix with water and apply to foliage. For best results, apply in spring or early summer when weeds are young and actively growing. Calcide can also be used in fall as a clean-up treatment. Heavy vegetation or difficult to control perennial weeds may require a repeat application. Complete kill will occur within 3 weeks. This product can provide long term control for up to 1 year. Effectiveness will be influenced by soil type, weather conditions, rainfall, etc. **Later's Calcide** does not corrode spray equipment and does not stain metal, stone or concrete.

IMPORTANT: Apply when the air is calm to avoid spraydrift. When spraying near desirable trees and shrubs keep the spray off the stems and foliage of these plants. Do not use on lawns or in flower and vegetable gardens. Do not flood the ground after applying. Do not apply to slopes as run off or leaching may damage desirable plants.

HOW TO USE:

Apply with a watering can or sprayer. Fill watering can/sprayer ½ full with water. **Calcide** and stir. Add rest of water and stir again. Then apply. Cover the area to be treated thoroughly.
