DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Machine cleaner must be added by closed system transfer.

- 1. 1-3% Grotanol* SR-1, depending upon coolant contamination, should be added during the last shift allowing at least a 6 hour cleaning period before draining the coolant.
- 2. Disinfect machine surfaces not reached by the circulating coolant/cleaner with 0.54% solution of Grotanol* SR-1.
- 3. Flush with clean water.

FIRST AID:
