DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is to be used for the manufacture of industrial microbiocides which are registered under the Pest Control Products Act.

PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, rubber gloves and protective clothing (hats, long sleeve shirt, long pants and boots) when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

DISPOSAL

- 1. Triple or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.

FIRST AID

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

A. Symptoms of Nabam Poisoning:

May cause skin, eye, and respiratory tract irritations. May cause skin sensitization reaction.

B. Antidote:

Wash skin with soap and water. Flush eyes with copious amounts of water.

If Nabam was ingested within the last few hours and if copious vomiting has not occurred, the stomach should be emptied and steps taken to limit gastrointestinal absorption. If the patient is fully alert and not exhibiting signs of central nervous system depression, use physical means to induce vomiting. When vomiting stops, administer charcoal and cathartic orally. If the patient exhibits signs of central nervous system depression or fails to vomit within 30 minutes, the stomach should be emptied by gastric intubation, aspiration and lavage with slurry of activated charcoal. Instill activated charcoal following lavage. Include a cathartic to hasten elimination. Caution: Monitor fluid balance and serum electrolytes.
