GENERAL LIMITATIONS

Mixers and loaders handling Busan® 11-M1 must use a closed system designed by the manufacturer to enclose the soluble powder to prevent it from contacting handlers. The system must be capable of removing the soluble powder from the shipping container and transferring it into mixing tanks and/or application equipment. In addition, mixers, loaders, and other handlers engaged in any activities which may result in contact with the product must be wearing the Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) as specified in the “PRECAUTION” section of this label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Busan 11-M1 is a modified barium metaborate pigment for use in paints, other coatings, and plastics. Information on the use of Busan 11-M1 for preservation of paint and other coatings will be furnished upon request when a description of the problem is provided.

PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Personal Protective Equipment: Dust mask, goggles, long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks and shoes, and chemical resistant gloves should be worn by workmen handling Busan 11-M1. Mixers, loaders, and other handlers using engineering controls (closed system), must wear a long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks and shoes. Workmen should avoid contact with Busan 11-M1, washing thoroughly after handling.

FIRST AID

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

STORAGE

Keep in original container during storage. Store product in cool, dry, well ventilated place away from seed, feed, fertilizer, or other pesticides. Keep away from fire or open flame, or other source of heat.

DECONTAMINATION & DISPOSAL

Do not reuse this container for any purpose. This is a recyclable container, and is to be disposed of at a container collection site. Contact your local distributor/dealer or municipality for the location of the nearest collection site. Before taking the container to the collection site:

1. Triple- or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.
2. Make the empty, rinsed container unsuitable for further use.

If there is no container collection site in your area, dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.

For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the Provincial Regulatory Agency. Contact the manufacturer and the Provincial Regulatory Agency in case of a spill, and for clean-up of spills.
