DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- 1. Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 400 mL of AQUARIUS LIQUID ALGAECIDE per 10,000 L of pool water.
- 2. Weekly maintenance dosage is 200 mL of AQUARIUS LIQUID ALGAECIDE per 10,000 L of pool water.
- 3. For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of superchlorination product employed and wait for at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.
- 4. For visible algae, when superchlorination is not employed, add 1 L of AQUARIUS LIQUID ALGAECIDE per 10,000 L of pool water.

Do not apply when swimmers are in the immediate vicinity (a 15-minute restricted entry interval is recommended)

PRECAUTIONS:

If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
