Busan 72 is an emulsifiable microbicide concentrate used to inhibit the growth of fungi that causes the degradation of wet lap or sheet pulp, mulch paper, and chrome-tanned leather.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For the preservation of wet lap or sheet pulp, Busan 72 is dispersed in water and applied uniformly to the exposed surfaces by means of sprays or applicator rolls in amounts sufficient to provide a total of 250 - 1000 grams of Busan 72 per tonne of oven-dry fiber.

For the preservation of mulch paper, Busan 72 is dispersed in water and applied uniformly to the surfaces of the mulch paper by tub sizing methods or by means of sprays or applicator rolls prior to any coating of the paper with wax, polyethylene, or other protective materials. The amount of dispersion applied should be sufficient to provide a total of 750 - 1250 grams of Busan 72 per tonne of air-dry paper.

To prevent the growth of mold on chrome-tanned leather, Busan 72 is dispersed in water and added to the chrome liquor in amounts sufficient to provide 80 - 165 grams of Busan 72 per 1000 kg of hides.

PRECAUTIONS

DANGER KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. May be harmful if absorbed through the skin. Workmen handling the product should wear rubber gloves and goggles and should avoid contact of the product with clothing or skin. After any exposure, wash promptly and thoroughly with an abrasive soap and cool water and finally with glycerin. Apply Busan 72 only as specified on this label. Do not reuse drum.

FIRST AID

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

Eye exposure: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Skin or clothing exposure: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Inhalation: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Ingestion: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Note to physician: Probable mucosal damage following ingestion may contraindicate gastric lavage.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse this container for any purpose. This is a recyclable container, and is to be disposed of at a container collection site. Contact your local distributor/dealer or municipality for the location of the nearest collection site. Before taking the container to the collection site:

1. Triple- or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.
2. Make the empty, rinsed container unsuitable for further use.

If there is no container collection site in your area, dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
