DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Lightly coat the areas where insects are found and may hide such as cracks and crevices around pipes and drainage systems, window frames, floorboards and entrance ways. Apply Chemfree Insectigone Insect Control Powder for Food Processing Plant at a rate of 500 g/100 m₂ with a manual dust applicator. Hit insects directly where possible. Repeat treatment if pests reappear or after cleaning.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. In food processing plants, apply only when plant is not in operation. Cover or remove all food processing equipment, packaging material and utensils before application. Wash all surfaces that may contact food and rinse with potable water before re-use.
