DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- 1. Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 150 mL per 10,000 liters of pool water.
- 2. For pool water having visible algae, add 250 mL per 10,000 liters of water. Circulate pool water for a minimum of 6 hours before wintering.

For Covered Pools: Apply dosage as indicated above, dependent upon whether visible algae growth is present.

For Uncovered Pools: Apply dosage as indicated above, dependent upon whether visible algae growth is present. A weekly maintenance dosage of 35 mL per 10,000 liters of water is then recommended.

PRECAUTIONS
