DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR RECIRCULATING COOLING WATER TOWERS:

- 1) Initially feed 6 litres per 10 000 litres of water to be treated (60 ppm active quaternary). If satisfactory control is not achieved, this dosage may be increased to 8 litres per 10 000 litres. Repeat this dosage every seven days or more frequently if required.
- 2) Once control is achieved, dosage should be reduced to 2 - 3 litres per 10 000 litres of water (20 - 30 ppm quaternary). If slime reforms, return to initial treatment levels.

FIRST AID

If on skin or clothing: take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If in eyes: hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Eye and skin irritant. Avoid ingestion, inhalation and contact with skin, eyes and clothing. When handling this concentrate wear goggles or a face shield, chemical-resistant gloves, long pants, a long-sleeved shirt, and shoes plus socks. Where there is a risk of contact wear protective clothing. Avoid contact with metals. Store away from oxidizing materials, heat, ignition sources, food, and food containers.
