POKON ORNAMENTAL PLANT SPRAY INSECTICIDE

Combats harmful insects: aphids, young caterpillars, thrips and white fly on indoor ornamental plants. With special valve to hold can upside down to spray the underside of the leaves. No danger to leaves due to evaporation chill.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Shake vigorously before use. Do not spray in excess so that the drops flow together and the plant becomes entirely wet. Repeat treatment after one week. Do not spray onto open blooms nor in full sun, early morning or evening preferred. Direct sunlight can deactivate pyrethrins and make its insecticidal properties ineffective. Do not use for oleanders and Ficus benjamina, pot roses and Adiantum. Use with caution on young plants and new growth. Insects must be contacted by spray to be killed.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Avoid inhalation of spray mist, contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Do not contaminate food. Cover aquariums in the vicinity. Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat. Do not puncture or incinerate container or store at temperatures over 50° C.

FIRST AID: IF SWALLOWED, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. IF IN EYES, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
