## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

MTC-10 Microbicide Concentrate is for use in manufacturing, formulating or repackaging. It is to be used only for the manufacture of industrial microbicides which are registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*.

## **PRECAUTIONS**

### **DANGER PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONEL**

**DANGER: POTENTIAL SKIN SENSITIZER.** Corrosive, causes eye and skin damage. Harmful if swallowed. Wear a full-face NIOSH-approved respirator, chemical-resistant gloves, long pants, a long-sleeved shirt, shoes plus socks and a chemical-resistant apron and safety glasses or face shield during mixing/loading, clean-up and repair activities. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, clothing, or the contamination of food. Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, and when using tobacco or the toilet. Keep away from open flame. Users should remove clothing/protective equipment immediately if this product comes in contact with the skin through soaked clothing or spills. Then, thoroughly wash the skin and put on clean clothing. Discard clothing or other absorbent materials that have been drenched or heavily contaminated with the concentrate of this product. Do not re-use them. Keep the container closed when not in use. Do not re-use the container.

## **FIRST AID**

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

**If in eyes :** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**If on skin or clothing :** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**If inhaled :** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

**If ingested :** Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Note to physician: This product contains petroleum distillates. Probable mucosal damage following ingestion may contraindicate gastric lavage.
