DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

DIMET is for use in manufacturing, formulating, or repackaging. It is to be used for the manufacturing of industrial microbicides which are registered under the Pest Control Products Act.

PRECAUTIONS

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL

Corrosive to the eye. DO NOT get in eyes. Corrosive to skin. DO NOT get on skin. Potential skin sensitizer. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, clothing and the contamination of food. Wear safety glasses (goggles), rubber gloves and protective clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling.

FIRST AID

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
