**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** Close all doors and windows. Place unit in upright position on floor of empty van. Point valve away from eyes. Depress valve and lock in open position. Exit from van. Note:

Posting the van is a requirement for this use. Keep doors, etc. shut for 30 minutes. Ventilate the area by opening doors, etc. Re-entry into treated area can occur after 4 hours of aeration. Total release of chemical will occur within 2 minutes. Use 2 sanitized untis in vans over 50 m<sup>3</sup>.

**PRECAUTIONS:** KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not swallow or inhale. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wash after using. Toxic to fish. CONTENTS UNDER PRESSURE. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves, or other sources of heat. Do not store above 50EC. Do not puncture or incinerate can. Do not use in presence of open flame or spark. To prevent possible exposure to the operator upon opening the valve at the start of the treatment or when the van needs to be entered, a cartridge respirator and eye protection need to be worn.
