#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

WSCP Liquid Microbicide is for use in manufacturing, formulating or repackaging. It is to be used only for the manufacture of industrial microbicides which are registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*.

### **PRECAUTIONS**

### PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORISED PERSONNEL

Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes. Avoid contact with skin and clothing.

### FIRST AID

Take container, label or product nam e and Pest Control Product Registration Num ber with you when seeking medical attention.

**If in eyes:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gen tly with water for 15-20 m inutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**If on skin or clothing:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

**If inhaled:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an am bulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

**If swallowed:** Call a poison control centre or doctor im mediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if ab le to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
