PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Harmful in contact with skin and if swallowed. Irritating to eyes. Wear protective gloves and face shield when handling. If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.
