DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To be used in the manufacture of insecticides which are registered under the Pest Control Products Act. This product is to be used with approved solvents, carriers, propellents, etc. in the manufacture of insecticide sprays.

PRECAUTIONS: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs.

Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
