PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL

Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Avoid breathing vapours. Handle concentrate in a ventilated area. When handling concentrate, wear protective clothing such as a long-sleeved shirt, long-legged pants, hat, gloves and boots resistant to aromatic solvents, i.e. neoprene or nitrile butadiene rubber. The use of a respirator approved by CSA for filtering spray mists or organic vapours is recommended when handling the concentrate in a confined area. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Discard contaminated leather articles including shoes. This product is a (mild) skin sensitizer. Repeated exposure may cause allergic reaction in sensitive individuals. If this should happen, discontinue use and consult a physician. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and water supplies.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

COMBUSTIBLE. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not cut or weld container.

FIRST AID

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give **any** liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Contains an aromatic petroleum solvent. Treat symptomatically. If exposed, plasma and red blood cell cholinesterase tests may indicate degree of exposure (baseline data are useful). Atropine, only by injection, is the preferable antidote. Oximes such as pralidoxime chloride may be therapeutic if used early; however, use only in conjunction with atropine. Employ supportive care. Treatment should be based on judgment of the physician in response to reactions of the patient.

AGRICULTURAL CHEMICAL

Do not ship or store with food, feeds, drugs or clothing.

USE PRECAUTIONS/ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, crustaceans and birds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning or disposal of wastes.

STORAGE

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, by cleaning of equipment or by disposal of wastes.

Store in original container in secured dry storage area. Prevent cross-contamination with other pesticides and fertilizers. Do not store above 38°C for extended periods of time. Storage below 8°C may result in formation of crystals. If product crystallizes, store at 22°C to 32°C and agitate to redissolve crystals. If container is damaged or spill occurs, use product immediately or dispose of product and damaged container as indicated below.

DISPOSAL

Canadian formulators of this product should dispose of unwanted active ingredient and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations. For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill, and for clean-up of spills.

Dursban HF insecticidal concentrate may be used only in the manufacture of an insecticide which is registered under the Pest Control Products Act.
