DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To be used only in the manufacture of antimicrobial products registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT. Manufacturers are responsible for their own registrations.

FIRST AID:

IF SWALLOWED: call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
