PRECAUTIONS

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not breathe the dust. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Avoid contact with eyes or prolonged skin contact, inhalation of dust and contamination of food and feed.

FIRST AID

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

No specific antidote. Employ supportive care. Treatment should be based on judgment of the physician in response to reactions of the patient.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD

Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters. Do not contaminate domestic or irrigation water supplies.

STORAGE

Do not contaminate food, feed or water by storage or disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open burning is prohibited.
