Non-staining, non-flammable. Kills on contact: Flies, mosquitoes, fleas, flying moths, gnats, spiders, bedbugs, sow bugs, carpet beetles, centipedes, aphids, leafhoppers, ants, silverfish, wasps. Insects must be hit by spray to be killed. For best results against specific insect infestations, use Raid Crawling Insect system or Raid Flying Insect system.

DIRECTIONS: FOR INDOOR USE, FLYING INSECTS: Shake before using. Close all doors and windows. Spray RAID up into the air with sweeping motion, keeping about 1 m from interior walls, fabrics and furniture. Keep room closed for 15 minutes. Ventilate sealed areas after treatment. About 12 seconds of spraying clears an average sized room (28 cubic metres). CRAWLING INSECTS: Must be hit by spray to be killed. FLEAS: Spray infested areas such as pet's bed and resting quarters. BEDBUGS: Take beds apart. Spray frames, joints, mattresses, particularly tufts and seams, floorboards, mouldings and baseboards. FOR OUTDOOR USE ON FLOWERS AND SHRUBS: Spray with slow, sweeping motion, keeping 30 to 45 cm away from all plants. Avoid wetting. A light spray kills pests effectively. Spray only when air is still and temperature is under 32 deg. C. Do not spray in direct sunlight, early morning or evening preferred. Use with caution on young plants and new growth.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Cover fish bowls and remove pets for one hour when spraying rooms. Avoid inhalation. Cover food and food utensils. Do not spray directly on skin or pets. KEEP FROM FREEZING. CONTENTS UNDER PRESSURE. Do not puncture or incinerate container or store at temperatures over 50 deg. C. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat.

FIRST AID: If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If accidentally swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If inhaled, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL: When empty, press button to release pressure, discard in household garbage.
