This insecticide is for use only in the automatic Mister dispenser, which releases 27.5 mg. of insecticide every 7-1/2 minutes. The continuous use of this insecticide will reduce flying insect populations (flies, mosquitoes and gnats) within a few hours. One can protect a room up to 170 cubic metres for up to 30 days.

USE AREAS: Restaurants, Food Plants, Hospitals, Food Service Establishments, Lodges, Resorts, Dairies, Horse Stables, Cow Barns and Poultry Houses while they are in operation. Also for use in Meat Processing Plants when not in operation. Use area must have at least 170 cubic metres of free flow air space. DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Dispenser must be located 2-3 metres above the floor at a point where air circulation will carry particles throughout the area. Do not install directly over food or food packaging surfaces. To install can, remove protective cap and screw into dispenser. CAUTION: in meat packing plants, only spray when plant is not in operation. No exposed meat products, ingredients or packaging materials to be left in the room. Any treated surface that may contact meat food products should be washed and rinsed thoroughly with potable water after spraying and before re-use. PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Container may explode if heated. Do

not expose to temperatures above 50 degrees C. Do not puncture or incinerate. Do not contaminate food, feed or water. Do not spray over milk or milking equipment. Avoid contact with skin and inhalation of spray mist. Wash after using. Contents toxic to fish and birds. Do not install directly over polished, plastic, or varnished surfaces. Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged persons are confined.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press valve to release all remaining pressure. Dispose of empty container in accordance with provincial requirements. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product and the cleanup of spills, contact the provincial regulatory agency or the manufacturer.
