DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Maintenance Directions:

1. Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 130 mL of **BioGuard Polygard** per 10,000 L of pool water.

2. Weekly maintenance dosage is 45 mL of **BioGuard Polygard** per 10 000 L of pool water.

Visible Algae Directions:

For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of superchlorination product employed and add 200 mL of BioGuard Polygard per 10,000 L of pool water. Wait at least 15 minutes before re-entering the pool.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed. Do not mix with any other chemical. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

FIRST AID

If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If in eyes**, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If swallowed**, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL: Rinse container thoroughly before discarding. Do not reuse empty container. Offer for recycling if available, or dispose in accordance with local and provincial regulations. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the Provincial Regulatory Agency or the manufacturer. Contact the manufacturer and the Provincial Regulatory Agency in case of a spill, and for clean-up of spills.
