DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- **1.** Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 60 mL of **Guardex ALGICIDE 60** per 10,000 L of pool water.
- **2.** Weekly maintenance dosage is 25 mL of **Guardex ALGICIDE 60** per 10,000 L of pool water.
- **3.** For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of superchlorination product employed and wait at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.
- **4.** For visible algae, when superchlorination is not employed, add 100 mL of **Guardex ALGICIDE 60** per 10,000 L of pool water.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not mix with any other chemical. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

FIRST AID: If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
