DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

This product is to be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT. Formulators are responsible for their own registrations.

This product should **not** be used or compounded with any reducing or oxidizing agents (such as calcium hypochlorite, solid perchlorate or nitric acid) since such mixtures may be explosive. Do not use in conjunction with soap or any anionic wetting agent. Wear goggles or face shield, rubber gloves and respirator if mist is generated. Under certain conditions, the use of protective creams may be advisable. Wash thoroughly after handling.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. DANGER - CORROSIVE TO EYES. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Wear goggles or face shield, rubber gloves and respirator if mist is generated. Under certain conditions, the use of protective creams may be advisable. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. This product is toxic to fish.

FIRST AID:

In case of contact with eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

In case of contact with skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed. Avoid alcohol.
