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DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the Pest Control Products Act.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. WARNING. HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED. HIGHLY CORROSIVE. DO NOT TAKE INTERNALLY. Causes eye and skin damage. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Use with adequate ventilation. Corrosive to the eye and skin. Do not get into eyes, on skin or clothing. Potential skin sensitizer. Wear rubber gloves and goggles or face shield when handling. Wash thoroughly after handling. Immediately remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

FIRST AID:

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Treat symptomatically.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

This product is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not discharge effluents containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, rivers, estuaries, oceans, or public waters.
