DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Dosages and method of application will depend upon the type of equipment to be treated. Initial slug dose: Use 2.4 liters of Magnatrol 43A per 10,000 liters of water. Maintenance slug dose: Use 1.2 to 2.4 liters of Magnatrol 43A per 10,000 liters of water one to three times per week depending of the season or as needed.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation and all contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wear safety glasses, chemical-resistant gloves, long pants, a long-sleeved shirt and shoes when handling this concentrate.

STORAGE: Do not store near drinking water, food or feed.

DISPOSAL: 1) Triple- or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.
2) Follow provincial instruction for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
3) Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
4) Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
5) For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill, and for clean-up of spills.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. Take container, label, or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
