DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

PULP and PAPER MILLS

Fennosan Q 25-C Paper Mill Slimicide is recommended for the control of slime-forming bacteria in paper mill systems.

POINT OF ADDITION: Fennosan Q25-C Paper Mill Slimicide should be added to the raw water or the contaminated areas of the paper machine for prevention of fouling in the associated spray areas or systems.

DOSAGE: Apply 50 mg/L to 250 mg/L of Fennosan Q25-C Paper Mill Slimicide as a slug dose. The maximum application rate must not exceed 28 kg Fennosan Q25-C per tonne of paper. If needed, repeat daily, or as needed. Badly fouled systems should be cleaned before initial treatment. If the product is applied manually, a dust mist respirator must be worn during application.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
