DIRECTIONS: Shake well before using. Hold can upright, point nozzle away from persons and press valve.

FOR USE IN: Homes and dwellings.

FLYING INSECTS: For flies, mosquitos, indian meal moths, flour moths

and certain other flying insects close all doors and windows. Apply for 2 - 3 seconds per 100 cu. metres of space. Direct mist upwards to all parts of the room. Also, direct mist into areas where insects are present and into normal resting areas such as around windows, screens, light fixtures and other surfaces known to attract flies and other flying insects. Keep in constant motion at least 1 m from interior walls, fabrics and furniture whenever possible. Keep doors and windows closed for 15 minutes. Sweep and destroy dead insects. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed for a period of 3 to 4 hours before re-entering.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Cockroaches, silverfish, ants and spiders. Spray hiding places such as cracks and crevices, moist areas, openings around sinks and pipes, behind cabinets and storage areas. Spray ant trails around door sills, window frames and nests. Insects must be contacted to be killed.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Do no place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat. Do not puncture or incinerate can or store at temperatures over 50 degrees Celsius. Do not spray in presence of open flame (including pilot lights) or spark or while smoking. Do not remain in treated areas. Do not spray food or utensils. Remove fish bowls, bird cages and animals before spraying. In homes and dwellings, remove or cover all exposed foods and cooking utensils before spraying. Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged persons are confined.
