## DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For use in manufacturing, formulating or repackaging. To be used only in the manufacture of a product which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT. Read technical bulletin for formulation details.

## PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Handle and use only as directed and at recommended rates. Do not contaminate water supplies, irrigation ditches, ponds, lakes, or streams.

## FIRST AID:

If swallowed:

## TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:
