Cooling Tower Systems: Do not apply by open pouring of the liquid to cooling water systems; a metering pump is required for this use.

For the control of algae, bacteria, and fungi in commercial and industrial cooling water systems, add this product as follows: Initial dose: 20-120 mL per 1,000 L water in the system. Maintenance dose: Every 1 to 5 days or as needed, 6.4 to 40 mL per 1,000 L of water in the system.

#### DISPOSAL

- 1. Triple-or pressure –rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.
- 2. Follow provincial instruction for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
- 3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
- 4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
