**DESCRIPTION**: Magnicide MW is a liquid compound used for the control of bacteria in industrial metalworking fluid.

**DIRECTION FOR USE:** To inhibit the bacterial growth use **Magnicide MW** at a concentration of 1.86 ppm every 4 weeks or 1.86 to 9.28 ppm every 8 to 12 weeks. For already highly contaminated fluids, an initial treatment of 3.71 to 9.28 ppm of **Magnicide MW** would be appropriate followed with periodic treatment.

#### PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

This product is corrosive to eyes and skin. Potential skin sensitizer. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not swallow. Avoid breathing vapors and spray mists. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash separately from other laundry before reuse. Wear long pants, a long sleeved shirt, chemical resistant gloves, a full face NIOSH-approved respirator and a chemical-resistant apron during mixing/loading, clean up, and repair.

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. If plastic, do not reuse empty container.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms. It is not to be used in circumstances that would cause or allow it to enter lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters in contravention of federal or provincial regulatory requirements. The requirements of applicable laws should be determined before using the product.

#### DISPOSAL:

- 1. Rinse the empty container thoroughly and add the rinsings to the mixture in the tank.
- 2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
- 3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
- 4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.

## FIRST AID:

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice
