TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically. Acute poisoning resulting from ingestion of excessive amounts or oral copper salts, most frequently copper sulfate, may cause death. Symptoms are vomiting, hematemesis, hypotension, melena, coma, and jaundice. Autopsy findings have revealed centrilobular hepatic necrosis. Fume exposure may occur. Health effects consist of irritation of upper respiratory tract, metallic or sweet taste, and nausea. Inhalation can result in congestion of nasal mucous membranes, sometimes of pharynx, and on occasion, ulceration with perforation of nasal septum. Inhalation of copper dust has caused, in animals, hemolysis of red blood cells, deposition of hemofuscin in liver and pancreas and injury to lungs.

STORAGE: Keep in original container during storage. Store product in a cool, dry, wellventilated place away from seed, feed, fertilizer, or other pesticides. Keep away from fire or open flame, or other heat source. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS: Powder will oxidize. Do not leave open. Store powder inside in dry area, -20 to 40°C (0 to 100°F).
